



Important Security Notice

With the support of Chief and Council from the communities we serve, Perimeter Aviation will conduct passenger screening (including a security inspection with a hand-held metal detector) during boarding at the Winnipeg and Thompson terminals.

Beginning on **Monday October 4th 2010**, all items carried by passengers will be inspected prior to boarding a flight.

Certain items are not permitted to travel as carry on; a list of these items is available at our check-in counter.

Effective November 1st 2010, flight closing times at the Winnipeg and Thompson terminals are 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure times.

Boarding will commence 10 minutes prior to the flight's scheduled departure time.

Please be available at the check-in counter and the boarding gate at the required times; failure to do so may result in a penalty.

Scissors	Pellet Guns
Toy Weapons	Axes and Hatchets
Alcohol / Alcoholic Beverages (sealed or not)	Crowbars
Glass Bottles or containers	Hammers
Metal Cutlery	Drills
Box Cutters	Saws
Ice Axes/Ice Picks	Screwdrivers
Knives	Wrenches and Pliers
Swords	Martial Arts paraphernalia
Over the counter medication (in excess of 1 bottle)	Brass Knuckles
Needles	Night Sticks
Baseball Bats	Nun chucks
Bows and Arrows	Stun Guns / Shocking Devices / Tasers
Hockey Sticks	Any sort of explosive material
Pool Cues	Fireworks
Ski Poles	Aerosols
Ammunition	Fuels (including lighter fluid and any highly flammable liquid)
BB guns	Compressed Gas Cylinders
Compressed Air Guns	Liquid Bleach
Firearms	Yeast
Flare Guns	Spray Paint
Flare Gun Ammunition	Drugs
Gun Lighters	Alcohol based liquids
Gun Powder	Hand sanitizer (in container over 0.2 oz)
